

This is a short biography of James the Just, Jesus brother, founder of the earliest proto-Christian community called The Way, and the only person who could come between the Apostle Paul and antinomianism. On October 21, 2002, Oded Golan, an Israeli engineer and antiquities dealer, announced that he had found a 1st century chalk ossuary that bore the Aramaic inscription Ya'akov bar-Yosef akhui di Yeshua, which in English means "James, son of Joseph, brother of Jesus." The announcement ignited a firestorm of competing accusations and determinations of authenticity and forgery. In 2004, Israeli authorities charged Golan with fraud, he was acquitted eight years later. Director James Cameron claimed the ossuary was genuine, the "missing link" to the Lost Tomb of Jesus, a documentary he was promoting at the time. We're not as concerned here with the authenticity of the ossuary as we are with the man who was supposedly in it. Who was this "James, son of Joseph, brother of Jesus?" This short biography is intended to give the general reader an overview of James' life, with a focus on his role in the continuation of Jesus' ministry, his founding of the first proto-Christian community, and his efforts to contain the Apostle Paul's doctrinal excesses. It is important to recall that John the Baptist, Jesus, and James the Just were all devout Jews, who lived their ministries in devotion to Mosaic law. Paul, in his efforts to evangelize the Gentiles, fought against the application of Mosaic law. This went against Jesus' own teachings, and led to what would ultimately become the schism between the Christians and the Jews. Still, for a short time known as the "tunnel period" between Jesus' crucifixion and the appearance of the first Christian writings, we have in James the Just a fascinating picture of how the ministry of an itinerant Jewish preacher could become the dominant world religion. For just over thirty years, one man kept Jesus' original ministry alive. So, again, who was this "James, son of Joseph, brother of Jesus?"
